| • | Read Psalm 119:153-160 |
| • | Make a list of the synonyms for God's word in 119:153-160. Is there a verse in this section that does NOT mention God's word? |
| • | List the requests the psalmist makes to God in 119:153-160 (Ex: "look upon my affliction and rescue me," "plead my cause and redeem me," "revive me," etc.). |
| • | What stands out to you as you look through that list of requests? |
| • | Based on what you see in the psalmist's requests, in what ways would you like to grow in your view of God and His word? |
| • | Three times the psalmist asks the Lord to revive him. For what reasons? Write out a simple prayer to God for revival in your own heart. |
