D3: Ministry—the example of Paul, 1 Thessalonians 1:5-10

Q1: Look back at your description of the gospel from your homework that was due March 2nd/5th. Make any changes to it that would make it clearer. Focus on the content rather than what it does.

Q3: Thinking about what 1 Thes. 1:6 teaches about ministry involving imitation, what work would you like to see God do in you to help your life become more worthy of imitation?

Q4: How is the gospel "sounding forth" from you these days (1 Thes. 1:8)? From what arenas of life do you sound forth the gospel well? From what arenas of life do you struggle to sound forth the gospel?

Scenario: A sister shares with you that one of her goals in the gospel mission is to be winsome and to be well-liked by those she pursues with the gospel. What questions would you ask her to get to her thinking behind that statement? Based on 1 Thessalonians 1:9-10, in what ways might her statement be something good? Something in need of correction?
