

# The Power at Pentecost

## Acts 2:1-13 (part 2)

### REVIEW:

*Three crucial features of the power at Pentecost:*

- I. The diverse outpouring, 2:1-4.
- II. The divergent outlooks, 2:5-13.
- III. The divine outline, 2:5-11 (today!).

*Three observations about the heart and outline of God that is revealed in Acts 2:5-11:*

1. The divine dispersion of the Jews into the nations until the kingdom.
  - *God promised to disperse Israel into the nations for disobedience, Dt 4:25-28; 28:58-68; Jer 9:12-16; 10:21-22; 13:22-25; 16:10-13; 18:11-12, 15-17; 23:1-2. See also Ezk 12:15; 20:23-24; 22:13-16; 34:5-6, 20-21.*
  - *God promised Israel's dispersion would be reversed prior to the kingdom, Dt 4:29-31; Ezk 11:16-21; 20:33-38, 41-44; 37:21-28. See also Is 11:1-12; 14:1; Ezek 28:25-26; 34:11-16; Amos 9:13-15; Zech 10:6-12.*
2. The divine assembly from the dispersion for the gospel mission, 2:5-11.
3. The divine outline for the gospel mission, 2:5-11.

### APPLICATION:
