Three revelations from Peter to battle the mockery and confusion at Pentecost:

I. The Spirit's presence at Pentecost, 2:14-21.

II. The Lord and Messiah' identity at Pentecost, 2:22-35.

Who is the Lord and Messiah? He is:

1. *Jesus the Nazarene who displayed God's approval, 2:22.*
2. *Jesus who was crucified because of God's plan, 2:23.*
3. *Jesus who was crucified by His enemies, 2:23.*
4. *Jesus who was raised from the dead by God, 2:24.*
5. *Jesus whose resurrection was prophesied of by David, 2:29-31.*
6. *Jesus who found confident joy in the face of death, 2:25-28.*

7. *Jesus whose resurrection identifies Him as Messiah, 2:29-32.*
8. *Jesus whose resurrection resulted in His exaltation, 2:33.*
9. *Jesus whose exaltation began the ministry of the HS, 2:33.*
10. *Jesus whose exaltation identifies Him as Lord over all, 2:34-35.*

III. The house of Israel's peril at Pentecost, 2:36.
