

A Religion Fit for Hell

Luke 16:19-31

INTRODUCTION:

In Luke, 16:19-31, Jesus documents in sobering detail bankrupt religion which accompanies a man into hell so that we might evaluate our present lives with sobriety.

Establishing that he is religious. . . .

- 1. His religion allowed him to make much of himself, 16:19.**
- 2. His religion allowed him to neglect those in need, 16:20-21.**
- 3. His religion failed him miserably at death, 16:22ff.**
- 4. His religion veiled the realities of hell for him, 16:23-25.**
- 5. His religion's consequential agonies can never be changed, 16:24-26.**
- 6. His religion arrogantly rejects God's sole means of saving grace, 16:27-31.**
