
The Sovereignty of God — A. W. Pink

"What impression is made upon the minds of those men of the world who. occasionally, attend a Gospel service? What are the conceptions formed by those who hear even those preachers who are counted as 'orthodox'? Is it not that a disappointed God is the One whom Christians believe in?... a God who is filled with benevolent intentions, yet unable to carry them out; that He is earnestly desirous of blessing



men, but that they will not let Him?"

Arthur Pink (1886-1952) lamented the low view of God in his day. He saw the church's little perspective on God as the primary cause of all that was wrong with churches, preaching, and the lives of professing Christians. The Sovereignty of God is Pink's earnest appeal to Christ's people to reject those ignoble views of God's comprehensive control over all things that prevent us from giving God the worship due Him. It includes an excellent section on the relationship of prayer to the sovereignty of God as well as helpful explanations of the seeming tension between God's sovereignty and human responsibility in difficult-tointerpret passages of Scripture.
