OT teaching: Exodus 33:11-23

NT teaching: John 1:14; 12:37-41; Luke 9:28-36; Matthew 16:27; 24:30; 25:31; Revelation 21:22-27.

NT teaching: Hebrews 9:22, 24-26

Exodus 3:10, 12-14; Isaiah 6:8-9; Jeremiah 1:6-7, 9; Ezekiel 2:3-4; 3:5-6; John 1:6, 33; 3:28

Jesus Christ was sent by His sending Father.

“Send” or “sent” in John’s Gospel: 50 times!

The Holy Spirit was “sent,” too – John 14:26; 15:26; 16:7

Disciples of Jesus (and the body of Christ) are sent ones as well.
