D1: My heart... His Word (Psalm 119).

- Read Psalm 119:17-24.
- Make list of the synonyms for God's Word in 119:17-24. Is there a verse in this section that does NOT mention God's word?
- What does the Psalmist say in these verses about his "soul" (the inner man), 119:20? What does that mean?
- In 119:17-19 what is the psalmist counting on God to do to help him live faithfully under God's word (3 things)?
- What does 119:20 say that indicates why the psalmist wants God to do for him what he requests of God in 119:17-19?
- What cools your passion for God's word? What seems to be more interesting to you than God's word?
- Have you ever requested God to do for you what the psalmist requested in 119:17-19? Write out a brief prayer to God now requesting God to do these things for you so that you can live more faithfully under His word.

D1: The Sovereignty of God - in general.

Be sure to read the greater context that each passage sits in to make sure you understand the context.

Q1: What does Psalm 115:3 tell you about God's sovereignty?

Q2: How is God different from us according to Isaiah 55:8-9? What does 55:8-9 provide an explanation for (see 55:7)?

Q3: How does David describe God's sovereignty in his prayer in 1 Chronicles 29:10-13?

Q4: Who created and sustains the world according to Colossians 1:13-17?

Q5: Over what places does Jesus exercise His authority or sovereignty according to Matthew 28:18?

Q6: How does God's sovereignty need to impact your life this week? What needs to change in your thinking? What attitudes need to change?

Spend some time in prayer worshiping God in His sovereignty. Entrust yourself to Him afresh, knowing that nothing is out of control in your life. Rest under His sovereign care and power!
