- As you consider Jesus' teaching about our enemies alongside these two lists from 119:113-120, how should you live among evildoers this week?
- Write out a prayer to God. Express your desire for Him and ask Him for help as you live for Jesus in a rebellious world.

## **The Wisdom of God in Proverbs for my Heart: "Reasons to watch over my heart"**

Read carefully through these proverbs: **5:12, 6:14, 25; 7:25; 12:25; 13:12; 16:5; 18:12; 20:9; 21:2; 23:17; 26:24-25; 28:14, 26.** What concerns does Solomon want his son to be aware of in his own heart?

From your own observations of these proverbs, **state no less than 5 reasons why you must watch over your heart** (What can you find in the heart that you must be on guard for? Ex: "spurning reproof," 5:12; "perversity," 6:14; etc.)
