### **D1: My heart... His Word (Psalm 119)**

- Read Psalm 119:121-128
- Make a list of the synonyms for God's word in 119:121-128. Is there a verse in this section that does NOT mention God's word?
- How does the Psalmist think about his enemies? Write down what he says in this section about his enemies.
- Where does the Psalmist turn as he faces his enemies? Write down the pertinent verses that describe where he turns. What does He say to God in those verses?
- What is there for you to learn for when you face hostilities against you for following Jesus Christ?
- How does the Psalmist stand out in contrast to his enemies? What are they known for? What is he known for?
- Write out a worshipful prayer to God expressing similar words to God as the Psalmist's for your situation.

## **The Wisdom of God in Proverbs for my Heart: “Marks of a Teachable Man”**

Read carefully through these proverbs: **1:5, 8, 33; 4:10, 13, 20-22; 5:1-2, 7; 6:20; 7:24; 9:9; 10:17; 12:15; 13:1, 10; 23:19, 22-23, 26; 24:32; 25:12.** What does it look like to be a teachable man? How important does Solomon believe teachability is for his sons?

From your own observations of these proverbs, **state no less than 5 marks of what it means to be a teachable man.**

You may want to consider memorizing a larger portion from Proverbs on being a teachable man: **Prov 2:1-11; 4:1-9; 7:1-5; 8:6-11; 8:32-36; 22:17-21; etc.**
