### D1: My heart... His Word (Psalm 119)

- Read Psalm 119:145-152
- Make a list of the synonyms for God's word in 119:145-52. Is there a verse in this section that does NOT mention God's word?
- In 119:145-148, list the "I \_\_\_\_\_..." statements (Ex: "I cried with all my heart" (119:145a), "I will observe Your statutes" (119:145b), etc.).
- What observations can you make from the list of "I \_\_\_\_\_..." statements? Any changes you would like to make personally in order to be able to make similar "I" statements like these? If so, what kind of changes?.
- Notice the psalmist's "near... far" language in 119:150-151. What observations or conclusions can you draw from these concerning your walk with Christ in this world?
- Write out a simple prayer to God from anything in this Psalm that stands out to you.

## **The Wisdom of God in Proverbs for my Heart: "Marks of an Arrogant Man"**

Read carefully through these proverbs: **6:17; 8:13; 11:2; 14:16; 15:25; 16:5, 18, 19; 18:1, 2, 12; 20:6; 21:4; 21:24; 25:14; 27:1, 2; 28:25; 29:23; 30:12, 13, 32.** What does it look like to be an arrogant man?

First - make a list from these verses of different words or phrases that describe what it means to be prideful or arrogant. Spend time praying over that list, confessing any sin and plead for humility from the Lord.

From your own observations of these proverbs, **state no less than 5 marks of arrogance.**
