## **LOOKING AHEAD...**

In preparation for the Saturday, April 25 lesson (D4 - The Qualifications: 1 Timothy 3:8-13). . . Carefully, thoughtfully, prayerfully read through the deacon qualifications in 3:8-13. Which qualification do you least understand (what it means to possess that qualification)? Which qualification do you think could be said that you currently possess? Which qualification would you most like to see growth in?

## **LOOKING DEEPER...**

*Look carefully and prayerfully through the elder qualifications in 1 Timothy 3:1-7 and Titus 1:6-9. Answer the following questions:*

**Which qualification(s) do you believe God has graciously been growing you in? Can you identify why you have grown in that qualification? What has God used to help you to grow?**

**Which qualification(s) do you desire to grow in? Can you discern why the presence of that qualification is weaker in your life?**

***Spend some time in prayer...*** Spend some time in prayer concerning the qualifications. Pray through each qualification in both lists if at all possible. Give thanks to God (and credit to God) for where there has been growth in your life. Ask for grace and help from God to grow in other areas. When will you pray through the qualifications again? What is your plan to regularly pray through the elder qualifications?
