LOOKING BACK...

LOOKING DAY BY DAY...

Consider making all three members of the triune Godhead a point of focus in your prayer life this week. Perhaps something like the following would fit into your prayer life:

1. Agree with the Father about the infinite magnitude of His glory. Return praise to Him for His wisdom to bring glory to Himself by conceiving and implementing a plan to save sinners from the penalty of their sins.

2. Agree with Jesus about His role in salvation. Thank Him for His obedience to remain on the cross until He finished absorbing the full weight of the Father's vengeance against all who would believe.

3. Agree with the Holy Spirit about the effects of His regenerating work in the life of an unbeliever. Ponder the fruitlessness of any effort on your part to justify yourself before God.

In preparation for Saturday, September 24 (D1 – God's Transformation of Man), think about the kind of person you were from the earliest years of your life. To whose authority were you willing to submit? What was the object of your greatest affections? How does that kind of person become a person who joyfully submits to the lordship of Jesus?
