Q5. Are you able to notice the signs that indicate when your heart shepherding is becoming weak? How can you use this to promote good heart shepherding going into the summer?

Q6. What are some things you can begin to do (or continue to do) that will strengthen the most important relationships in your life?

Q7. Are there areas in which you would like to serve at this church? Please know that any elder would love to hear from you.

Q8. Take a minute to pray for the other men who completed BUILD with you this year. Ask God to grant them His grace in the shepherding of their hearts and homes this summer.
