LOOKING BACK...

* Do you have any fear of death? Did this lesson change how you think about death?

* How has your thinking about the resurrection and rapture changed because of this lesson?

LOOKING DAY BY DAY...

Consider using part of your daily prayer time to agree with God about His ability to cause all events to work according to his chosen purpose.

1. What is the condition of your prayer life? How would you like to see your prayer life grow in the next two months?

2. What do you enjoy the most about your prayer life?

3. How are you encouraged that Scripture identifies prayer as approaching the throne of grace where the saint finds mercy and grace to help in time of need (Hebrews 4:16)?

4. How is your prayer life affected by the truth that God knows all things and has already determined how every event of your life will unfold?

In preparation for Saturday, November 4 (D1 – Four Questions for My Heart from Proverbs), think about how quickly our hearts seek to deceive us. Ask the Lord to prepare you to receive His assessment of the human heart.
