LOOKING DAY BY DAY...

Consider making all three members of the triune Godhead a point of focus in your prayer life this week. Perhaps something like the following would fit into your prayer life:

Agree with the Father about the infinite magnitude of His glory. Return praise to Him for His wisdom to bring glory to Himself by conceiving and implementing a plan to save sinners from the penalty of their sins.

Agree with Jesus about His role in the salvation of the lost. Thank Him for His obedience to the Father to remain on the cross until He finished absorbing the full weight of His Father's wrath against all who would believe.

Agree with the Holy Spirit about the effects of His regenerating work in the life of the one being saved. Agree with God about the fruitlessness of any effort on your part to justify yourself before God.

LOOKING AHEAD...

In preparation for Saturday, September 26 (D1 - God's Transformation of Man, Part 1), think about the kind of person you were from the earliest years of your life. To whose authority were you willing to submit in those days? What was the object of your greatest affections? Think about how THAT kind of person becomes joyfully willing to submit to the lordship of Jesus over their life.
