

- B) One OT man who grasped God's heart for the household.
 - Joshua 24:14-28 (Joshua).
- C) OT failures to grasp God's heart for the household.
 - Exodus 4:21-26 (Moses).
 - 1 Samuel 2:12-17, 22-26, 29-31 (Eli).
 - 1 Samuel 7:15-8:5 (Samuel).
 - 2 Samuel 7:1-11, 16, 18 (David: the priority of his house); 11:26-27; 12:9-10, 11a (David: the undoing of his own house).
 - 1 Kings 11:1-4, 9 (Solomon).

2. God's Concern for His Glory Within A Household

- A) The ease at which God is forgotten in the household.
 - Deuteronomy 6:10-12; 8:10-20 (11-14).
- B) The impact of one's faith on the entire household.
 - Acts 10:22-24, 44-45.
 - Acts 16:11-15.
 - Acts 16:22-34.

- C) The attack on the household.
 - 2 Timothy 3:1-9.
 - Titus 1:9-14; 2:1-10.
- D) The household can become an obstacle to the gospel.
 - Matthew 10:34-39; Luke 12:51-53; 14:26.
 - Luke 9:57-62.
 - Matthew 12:46-50; Mark 3:20-21, 31-35; Luke 8:19-21.

3. God's Concern for a Gospel-Centered Marriage

- A) Leading a wife requires a strong grasp on the gospel (and in the church).
 - Ephesians 5:25-33.
- B) A NT model marriage.
 - Acts 18:1-3, 24-28; Romans 16:3-5a.
