LOOKING BACK...

Review your notes from December 17 (Deacon Qualifications). As you review the notes you took in that session:

* Do any of the deacon qualifications sober you? Why?

* In which deacon qualification(s) do you see the Lord growing you over the last 6 months? Ask someone near to you what they see when they look at you through the lens of the deacon qualifications.

* Do you make it a regular practice to evaluate yourself in light of the deacon qualifications?

LOOKING DAY BY DAY...

Consider how you can keep the elder qualifications in front of you:

* There are 9 deacon qualifications in 1 Timothy 3:8-13. In the days between today and our next BUILD meeting, PRAY over each of these qualifications (perhaps one per day). Ask the Lord to grow your awareness of how your life bears evidence of these qualifications.

* Remind yourself of the role that the deacon plays between the elder leadership and the body. In light of this, why is it important for the deacon to be a man who is not double-tongued?

* There is good reason to believe that 1 Timothy 3:11 speaks to the character of a deacon's wife. As you look at verse 11, what must be true of the man in order for his wife to thrive in those areas?
