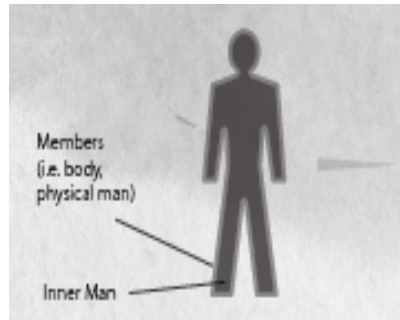
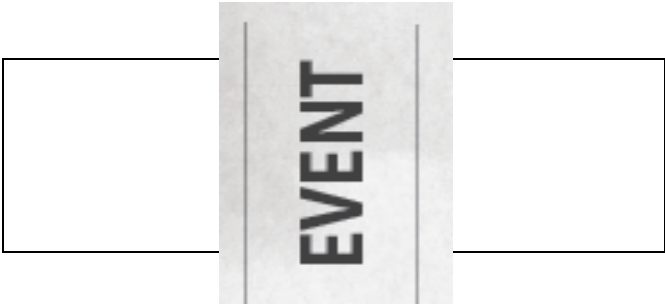

**EVENT—CONVERSION**

**Accomplished by God in the Gospel of Jesus Christ**

**1. The foundational truths of the gospel of Jesus Christ:**

- Jesus crucified (suffered) for sins
  - Jesus raised from the dead
  - Proclamation of repentance & faith for the forgiveness of sins in Jesus' name

**2. The benefits of the gospel of Jesus Christ (overlapping and simultaneous)**

**A theological summary for the gospel of Jesus Christ: “Penal Substitutionary Atonement”**

- Adoption (God is our Father):** Ro 8:14-17; Ga 4:4-7; Ep 1:5

- Reconciliation (no longer separated from God; at peace with Him):** Ro 5:10-11; 2Co 5:18-20; Co 1:19-22
- Positional Sanctification (declared to be holy):** 1 Co 1:2, 30; 6:11; Ep 5:25-27; Tts 2:14
- Justification (declared righteous):** Ro 1:17; 3:21-30; 5:1, 9; 1Co 6:11; 2Co 5:20-21; Ga 2:16; Ph 3:7-9; Tts 3:7

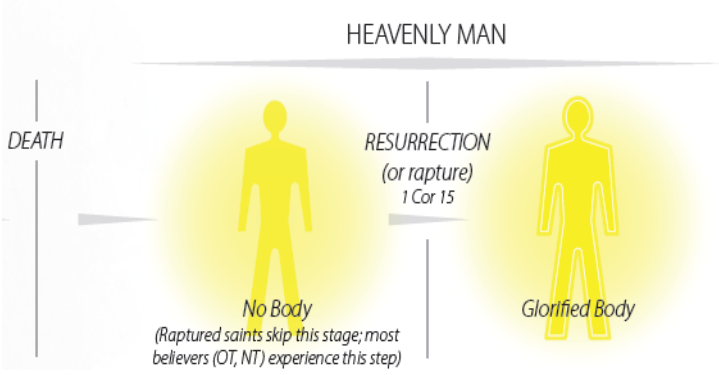
