LOOKING BACK...

1. Read Luke 10:38-42 and review the lesson notes from Mary and Martha, November 23, 2013.

a. Think about Martha's response. The passage says she was "distracted" with all her preparations, and Jesus said that she was "worried and bothered." When you are tempted to respond to your circumstances in that way, how will you use the gospel to shepherd your heart? What truths does your heart need to remember? How might that kind of heart shepherding change your response?

b. In what ways have you chosen to make Jesus your priority this week? What did that look like? Is there something that you should NOT have chosen that would have made Him a greater priority? What will you change for the coming week?

2. What have you learned recently from your daily time with God in His Word? How have you been encouraged?

LOOKING AHEAD...

3. In preparation for LESSON 7 – The Heart: Are You Passionate for Salvation’s Rest Hebrews 4:11-13, pray and ask God for clarity and understanding. Then slowly read Hebrews 3 and 4.

As you read, note every occurrence of the word “rest,” along with any pronouns (e.g., “it”) which refer to “rest.” Note what you learn about rest from each one. The first three have been done as an example.

VERSE	OBSERVATIONS ABOUT REST
3:11	<p><i>God</i> decided the people in the wilderness could NOT enter His rest</p> <p>They could not enter because they HARDENED THEIR HEARTS, PROVOKED GOD, TESTED GOD, WENT ASTRAY IN THEIR HEARTS, and DIDN'T KNOW GOD'S WAYS</p>
3:18	couldn't enter rest because they were DISOBEDIENT
3:19	couldn't enter rest because of UNBELIEF
