LOOKING BACK...

1. Review the lesson from February 8, "D3: Ministry—Paul's Example."

Ministry is all about the gospel. What is the gospel? What might you actually say when you are preaching the gospel to yourself or to others? Your assignment is to write out the gospel.

Please include aspects of God's character, your nature, Christ's sacrifice, and the result it has in your life today. Don't worry about making it perfect. Take a look at 1 Corinthians 15:1-4; 2 Corinthians 5:17-21; Titus 2:11-14; and Titus 3:1-8 if you need some help. The "gospel resources" hand-out and the "The New Creation" pamphlet may also be helpful.

2. Throughout the outline there are a number of application opportunities and questions to answer. Please choose at least one to thoughtfully answer. Identify Scripture which could help you grow in this area. If sin is revealed as you answer, please read 1John 1:9. How does that help you?
