


7. The family/home can become an obstacle to the gospel.

• If I put my household identity first and my identity in Christ underneath, what might you hear me saying?

"That's the way I was raised!"
"My family always argues!"
"Quick-tempers run in my family!"
"My dad never praised me."—etc.



• BUT, when I place my household & family identity UNDER my identity in Christ, then it is Christ's work in me that gets brought into the household, not vice-versa.
