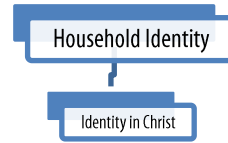

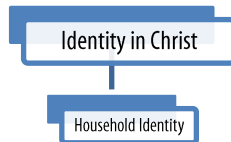
**7. The family/home can become an obstacle to the gospel.**

- If I put my *household identity first and my identity in Christ underneath*, what might you hear me saying?

“That’s the way I was raised!”  
 “My family always argues!”  
 “Quick-temper run in my family!”  
 “My dad never praised me.”—etc.



- BUT, when I place my household & family identity UNDER my identity in Christ, then it is Christ’s work in me that gets brought into the household, not vice-versa.
