#### **LOOKING BACK...**

1. Proverbs 14:1 says, "The wise woman builds her house, but the foolish tears it down with her own hands." In what ways, by God's grace, are you building your home? Are there ways that He has shown you that you are tearing it down? If so, how can you use the gospel to help you walk in repentance? Some areas of your home life to consider for these questions could include your heart attitude, your communication, and/or your actions, for example, how you spend your time, how you spend your money and resources, rest habits, priorities, etc.

2. What in this lesson is helpful in shepherding your heart? How might you apply what you have learned? How would that display the gospel?
