3. In preparation for LESSON 18 — The Heart: Are You Passionate for Salvation's Rest Hebrews 4:11-13, pray and ask God for clarity and understanding. Then slowly read Hebrews 3 and 4. As you read, note every occurrence of the word "rest," along with any pronouns (e.g., "it") which refer to "rest." Note what you learn about rest from each one. The first three have been done as an example.

VERSE	OBSERVATIONS ABOUT REST
3:11	God decided the people in the wilderness could NOT enter His rest They could not enter because they HARDENED THEIR HEARTS, PROVOKED GOD, TESTED GOD, WENT ASTRAY IN THEIR HEARTS, and DIDN'T KNOW GOD'S WAYS
3:18	couldn't enter rest because they were DISOBEDIENT
3:19	couldn't enter rest because of UNBELIEF
