D2 - THE HOME: BEARING GOD'S IMAGE IN SINGLENESS AND MARRIAGE

Before beginning your homework, take time to read and pray through Romans 8:28–30. Thank God for the wonderful assurance that those who love Him and are called according to His purpose know that He is conforming them to the image of His Son. Praise Him for the comfort that as one who bears His image, you can know even in the midst of a personal struggle or disappointment (past, present or future) that He is at work.

LOOKING BACK...

Review the lesson (D2 - THE HOME: Bearing God's Image in Singleness and Marriage). How was your perspective on being a Christian woman strengthened or changed?

God's design for women has implications for every season of life. Read the "Implications of God's design for us to bear His image in singleness and marriage" resource (separate hand-out). How has God used something in this chart to shape your thinking and encourage you in your present season as a Christian woman?



Read or sing, <i>Be Thou My Vision</i> , from the Wellspring songbook. In this hymn, the writer expresses his heart's desire to remain near to God and to faithfully keep Him His foremost priority. What phrases in this hymn identify specific blessings that he had received? (e.g. wisdom, truth, intimacy with the Lord, contentment, peace)
Think about the time you spend reading and meeting with the Lord. How are you doing?
How do the words of the song encourage you to persevere or renew your commitment to meet with God daily through His word? (If you are really struggling to be in the Word, talk with your Wellspring sister or discussion group leader).
LOOKING AHEAD In preparation for lesson 12, D1 - THE HEART: The Danger of Pride, read Deuteronomy 8:11-20. What will lead to pride, if the Israelites don't beware?
What will pride cause them to do?
