D1 - THE HEART: THE DANGER OF PRIDE

Read Ephesians 4:1-3. Prayerfully consider how Paul follows up his rich teaching in the previous chapters on the gospel of God's glorious grace first by imploring believers to live out their salvation with humility, gentleness, peace, love, and unity with others. As you work through the lesson, ask God to help you see where your life evidences pride rather than the qualities Paul listed.
