- -Leads to forgetting God
- -Usurping God given authorities in my life
- -Grows an entitlement attitude
- -Leads to laziness
- -Grows bitter jealousy/selfish ambition
- -Ungratefulness/Discontentment/Complaining
- -Self-confidence/Self-reliance or sufficiency
