### **LOOKING BACK...**

Review your notes from D1 – The Heart: Four Questions for My Heart from Proverbs. Which of the four questions stood out more for you? Why that particular question? What might God desire to accomplish in your life through that conviction?

### **LOOKING DAY BY DAY...**

Assessing my heart: Take another look at Proverbs 3:5-6. What does it mean to trust in the Lord with all your heart? What does Hebrews 4:12 say about counseling our heart when we are feeling confident in our own wisdom?

Controlling my heart: Look back at Proverbs 7:25, 23:17. Believers are called to turn from sin that seems so attractive. How should the believer control her heart so that she turns away from sin?

Reconsidering my heart: Look again at Proverbs 18:12. What is true about the condition of man's heart just before his life becomes undone spiritually? Are there any passages from my time in the Word this week that I can use to keep my heart from pride and instead walk in humility?
