INTRODUCTION:

6 Questions to investigate how God wants us to practice biblical relationships within the local church:

1. How does God want us to practice loving one another?

- Love one another (John 13:34-35)
- Love one another (1 John 3:11, 1 John 3:23)
- Love one another (1 John 4:11)

2. How does God want us to practice caring for one another?

- Care for one another (1 Corinthians 12:25)

- Bear one another's burdens (Galatians 6:2)

3. How does God want us to practice edifying one another?

- Build up one another (1 Thessalonians 5:11, Romans 14:19)

- Admonish one another (Romans 15:14, Colossians 3:16)

4. How does God want us to practice being humble with one another?

- Give preference to one another (Romans 12:10)

- Confess your sins to one another (James 5:16)

5. How does God want us to practice serving one another?

- Serve one another (1 Peter 4:10, Galatians 5:13)

- Wash one another's feet (John 13:14)

6. How does God want us to practice being unified with one another?

- Be devoted to one another (Romans 12:10)

- Let us not judge one another (Romans 14:13)
