THE DANGER OF PRIDE AND THE HOPE OF THE GOSPEL

LOOKING BACK ...

Review your outline from the lesson D1 – The Heart: The Danger of Pride and the Hope of the Gospel. Choose one of the "How About Me" questions. Look up the corresponding verses. Explain how you were helped to recognize and turn from that prideful attitude or action.

Read through the resource "41 Evidences of Pride". Identify one or more areas of pride with which you struggle. List some Scriptures that help you remember the truth about the gospel to encourage you in your battle with pride.

LOOKING DAY BY DAY ...

List a passage from your daily Bible reading that reveals prideful attitudes or actions in your own life. How will you repent and change?

LOOKING AHEAD ...

In preparation for D2 – The Home: Bearing God’s Image in Unity and Love, read through the resource entitled “D2 – The Home: Women in the Bible”, a four-page resource found in your notebook. Identify and write out something that is new to you, a good reminder, a surprise, an encouragement or that catches your attention and be ready to share with your discussion group.
