BUILDING OUR HOMES WITH GOD'S WORD (DEUTERONOMY 6)

Begin your homework with prayer. Ask the Lord to open your eyes to see what you need to see and for His grace to change what you need to change.

LOOKING BACK...

1. Review the principles from "Building Our Home with God's Word". Choose one of the principles to help you evaluate your biblical care for your household (your roommate or those you invite into your home). Is there anything that God has revealed to you that shows you how you can grow in your love and care for them? What are some things that you will implement this week?
2. How does the priority you place on your household relationships align with God's heart for the household, as revealed in His Word? Is there anything that you need to repent of? Are there steps you need to take to have a heart that places a high importance on family relationships/roommates/others?
3. How are you doing with shepherding **your own heart**? Are there any changes you need to make in order to have the right kind of spiritual influence on your household?

4. Read through Psalm 19: 7- 11 looking for ways that God's Word can benefit those in your household or those you invite into your home as you care for them? (See example after verse 7.)
- 7 The law of the LORD is perfect, restoring the soul; *(e.g who in my home needs restoration? How can I use God's Word to refresh my discouraged roommate?)*
The testimony of the LORD is sure, making wise the simple.
- 8 The precepts of the LORD are right, rejoicing the heart;
The commandment of the LORD is pure, enlightening the eyes.
- 9 The fear of the LORD is clean, enduring forever;
The judgments of the LORD are true; they are righteous altogether.
- 10 They are more desirable than gold, yes, than much fine gold;
Sweeter also than honey and the drippings of the honeycomb.
- 11 Moreover, by them Your servant is warned;
In keeping them there is great reward.

Choose a passage from your Bible reading that you can use to minister to your household or a passage that you can meditate upon to be well prepared to care for those in your household. What passage did you choose? What was the impact, or what are you praying the impact could be?

LOOKING AHEAD...

How was your heart affected by that sin?
