LOOKING BACK...

1. Review your notes from the "Biblical Womanhood" lesson. How does the lesson and God's Word help you better understand God's design for you as a woman?

2. God's design for women is a great privilege, so it's essential that we understand how to cultivate biblical womanhood. Describe ways you can keep from pursuing this in your own strength and, instead, rely on the power of the Holy Spirit and Christ's finished work on the cross on your behalf. Why is this distinction important? Some helpful verses to consider are Romans 6; Galatians 5:16-25; Titus 2:11-14; 3:1-8; Hebrews 12:1-2.

(If this is unfamiliar, or you are unsure how to answer this question, be sure to ask your discussion leader for help.)

3. On pages 5-6 of the worksheet ("Conclusion: What is Biblical Womanhood?"), prayerfully choose at least one area in which you would like to grow. Look up the verses associated with that area, then write out a prayer to God. Consider including the following in your prayer:
- Your desire and resolve rooted in the gospel to display His image more clearly in this way.
 - Your intention to do this as an expression of your love for Jesus (John 14:21), and how you will cultivate that as your motive.
 - Some specific things you will do, by His grace, to grow in this.
 - Your need for Him and your dependence on Him.

LOOKING AHEAD...

In preparation for the next lesson, D1-3 - Biblical Decision Making, think about the relationship between decisions you make and the Lord's will. Ask the Lord to give you an open mind to principles from Scripture that should guide us as we make decisions.
