- The removal of guilt – ‘expiation’.
 - The removal of guilt in Scripture (expiation). John 1:29; Hebrews 9:26-28; 2 Corinthians 5:21

- The removal of God’s wrath – ‘propitiation’.
 - The removal of God’s wrath in Scripture (propitiation): Romans 3:25; Hebrews 2:17; 1 John 2:1-2; 4:10.

- The renewal of relationship between God and the sinner – ‘reconciliation’.
 - The renewal of relationship in Scripture (reconciliation): 2 Corinthians 5:18-21; Romans 5:11; etc.
