Hold on to these observations:

1. Hearing Jesus pray made His disciples prayerful, 11:1.
2. Prayer is a disciple's primary means of expressing his self-emptying devotion and need for God, 11:1-4.
3. Jesus intends our prayers to reflect our family/community relationships, 11:3-4.

Prayerful children desire their Father to glorify His:

1. Comprehensive and uncommon character, 11:2a.

2. Kingly reign, 11:2b.

3. Giving nature in their basic daily needs, 11:3.

4. Limitless forgiveness as they extend limitless forgiveness, 11:4a.

5. Protecting presence in their weakness before temptation, 11:4b.
