What is biblical repentance? J.C. Ryle

- 1. Repentance begins with the knowledge of sin.*
- 2. Repentance expresses genuine sorrow for that sin.*
- 3. Repentance leads to confession of sin before God.*
- 4. Repentance leads to a thorough breaking off from sin.*
- 5. Repentance produces a habit of deep hatred of all sin.*
- 6. Repentance is inseparably connected with lively faith in and love for Jesus Christ.*
