7. Get excited about baptism (Romans 6:3-4).

8. Pursue holiness (Romans 6:16-18).

9. Fight sin (Romans 6:12-13).

10. Exalt grace (Romans 5:20-21).

11. Silence the legalist (Romans 5:20-21).

12. Arrest the antinomian (Romans 6:1, 2, 14).
