

## **Why Genesis?** **Genesis 1-3 and Miscellaneous Scriptures**

INTRODUCTION:

So why are we going to spend several months studying the first three chapters of Genesis? Because of what a detailed study of Genesis will reveal about...

### **I. ...God.**

(Gen1; 1Sam2:8; 2Chr2:12; Ps19; Ps33:6-9; Ps100:1-3; Ps102:25; Ps104; Ps115:15; Ps146:5-6; Prv8:22-31; Isa40:12,28; Isa42:5,8; Isa44:24; Isa45:6-7,18; Isa 51:13-15; Acts4:24; Acts14:15; Acts17:24-28; Rom1:19-25; Eph3:9; 1Tim6:13; Heb11:3; Jn1:1-3; Col1:16-18; Rev4:11)

### **II. ...the universe.**

(Gen1:1; Ps19; Rom11:36; Eccles7:13; Rom8:20-21; Col1:16-18; Heb1:3)

### **iii. ...mankind.**

(Gen1:26-31; 2:5-8; 2:15-25; ch3; 5:1; 6:5; 8:21; 11:1-9; Rom3:10-18; 5:12-21; 8:20-23,29)

### **iv. ...the Bible.**

- No other book of the Bible is quoted more in the rest of the Bible than Genesis!
  - Adam, Noah, and Abraham are mentioned by name throughout the Old Testament, and they are treated as historical characters.
  - There are at least 200 quotations of Genesis in the New Testament.
  - There are over 100 quotations and references in the New Testament to Genesis 1-11 (these are the chapters most often discredited as being non-historical).
  - All 11 chapters are specifically alluded to in New Testament.
  - Every New Testament writer alludes to something specific in Genesis 1-11.
  - Jesus refers to something specific in each of the first 7 chapters of Genesis.
- In all of the Bible's references to the first eleven chapters of Genesis, there is not a single reference that treats Genesis 1-11 as anything other than a historical record.

(Jn3:19-21; Rom1:18-23; 1Cor1:18-31)

**vi. ...Christian culture.**

(Gen1; Ex20:11; Isa44:24; 45:12; 1Cor1:18-31; 2:12-16)

**vii. ...the Gospel.**

(Isa 43:25; 2Cor4:6; 5:17)

**VIII. ... (work, marriage, language, temptation, Satan, heaven, and many other things!).**
