REVIEW:

In Luke 19:11-27, Jesus provides yet another preview description of the new man identity that He will achieve through His death and resurrection for all who believe Him.

The King's slave:

- 1. Advances the King's interests, Lk 19:13, 15.**
- 2. Is surrounded by adversity, Lk 19:14, 27, 20-26.**
- 3. Gives an account for the advancement of the King's interests, Lk 19:15.**
- 4. Isn't the owner of anything he has, Lk 19:13, 15, 16, 18.**
- 5. Is faithful within his abilities to advance the King's interests, Lk 19:16-19.**
- 6. Avoids breaking even with the King's interests, Lk 19:16-23.**
- 7. Anticipates the arrival of an extremely generous King, Lk 19:17, 19.**
