Abraham waited (Genesis 12:2-3; 16:1-2; 17:16).

Joseph waited (Genesis 39; 40; 41:1; 50:20).

Moses waited.

Israel waited (Deuteronomy 2:7, 14-18).

Saul did not wait (1Samuel 13:8-14; Acts 13:21).

Jeremiah waited.

Daniel waited (Daniel 9:2).

Zacharias and Elizabeth waited (Luke 1:67-79).

Simeon was waiting (Luke 2:25-32).

Anna was waiting (Luke 2:36-38).

a father waited (Mark 9:21).

a woman waited (Luke 13:10-17).

a lame man waited (John 5:1-9).

a hemorrhaging woman waited (Matthew 9:20).

the disciples waited (Acts 1:4; Luke 24:49).
