



**B. Layer Two: Disciple men in hermeneutics, exegesis, homiletics, and theology (H3).**

"Hermeneutics" = the rules for interpreting Scripture.

Literal - Grammatical - Historical  
The words . . . in relationship to each other . . . in their context.

"Exegesis" = the application of the rules to biblical texts.

"Homiletics" = crafting a main point, outline and message in sermon form from the text.

"Theology" = the truths derived from texts categorized by subject (Theology Proper, Bibliology, Christology, Pneumatology, Soteriology, Ecclesiology, Eschatology, etc.)
