I. The Promised King (who is the Son of David).

IV. The Coming King (who will establish His throne).

V. The Hated King (who will judge the nations).

VI. The Pardoning King (who commissions His servants).

VII. The Separated King (who never allies Himself with man's authority).

Mt 2:1ff; Lk 3:1ff; 4:5-8; Jn 6:15; Mt 22:17-22; Jn 18:36-37.

VIII. The Trusted King who sustains all His servants.

Mt 6:10; Lk 21:10-19.
